Arrive by 1:30 p.m. each week; be ready to ride at 1:45 (Aug. 31 at 12:30 p.m.)

Aug. 3 – part of Ozaukee Interurban Trail: We will meet at the northeast corner of the parking lot behind St. Paul Fish Company, 6200 W. Mequon Road in Mequon. Our route runs north through Cedarburg and on to Grafton and back for about a 20-mile ride on mostly asphalt with some gentle hills. Afterward, you have the option of meeting at the Mequon Public Market (next to our parking area), where there are many dining options and areas to gather indoors or outside on the large patio.

(The south parking area is for boat owners.) There is a bathroom near the parking area. We will ride to Winthrop Harbor Marina in Illinois, our turn-around point. It has bathrooms, a beer garden, and often music on Sunday afternoons. Round trip is about 20 miles on a variety of surfaces, including asphalt, sidewalks and a little gravel. This is not a bike path but a mostly flat bike route using lightly

traveled roads and sidewalks -- road bikes are fine for this ride. Afterward, you have the option of meeting at Waterfront Warehouse, 3322 Sheridan Road in Kenosha, a short drive from the marina.
